> Key Concepts

- Every day history is being made... and forgotten.
- Day One can help you quickly record personal and family history as it happens.
- Day One is available for iOS devices (iPhones and iPads) and Mac computers
 - iPhone and iPad: <http://bit.ly/DayOne-iOS>
 - Portable devices—Available wherever you are.
 - GPS-enabled—Collect valuable, contextually-rich life metadata.
 - Exif data—Photographic data is automatically used for time, date, and location.
 - Search—Look up entries written in your current location so you can relive past moments.
 - Sync
 - Day One syncs your data between your Mac and iOS devices. Create an entry and see it appear within seconds on other devices. This is helpful for quickly capturing moments with your iOS devices, then elaborate on them in greater detail on your Mac.

- Mac: <http://bit.ly/DayOne-Mac>
 - Multiple journals—Organize entries as you like. Some users like to create a home, work, church, and other journals for different contexts. (New in Day One 2.0.)
 - Multiple photos—Add up to ten, inline photos per entry. (New in Day One 2.0.)
 - Recording past events—Create entries for past dates and locations. Day One will automatically add historical weather (from 1960s and later for some locations) to add extra interest to past events.

 - Tagging—Tag entries for easy filtering and reliving past events.
 - Filters and Search—Easily sift through past entries and find the exact entries you're looking for.
 - Exporting—Export journal data in a variety of formats: PDF, plain text, and more.
