Remember:

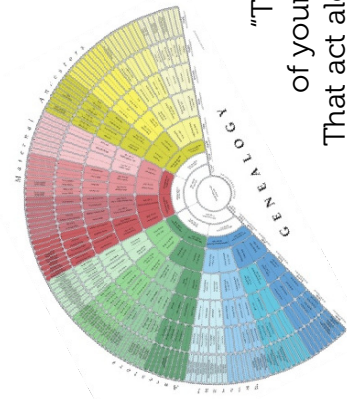
Not perfect and delivered is much better than perfect and only in your mind!

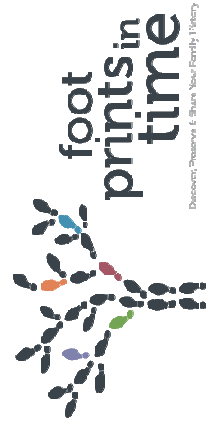

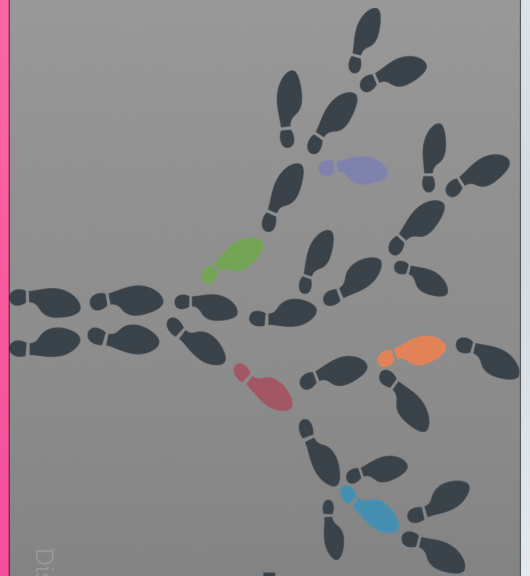
