BEST PRACTICES

You will be more successful in helping others complete ordinances for their ancestors if you do the following:

1. **Support priesthood leaders**—Work under the direction of priesthood keys.
2. **Be proactive**—Prayerfully consider who you can invite to engage youth, young families, converts, empty nesters, and other members in family history and temple service.
3. **Prepare for the visit**—Seek guidance from the Spirit in how to help each family to be successful. Get to know the family and what they would like to accomplish. Ask for permission to spend time in their tree before you visit. Use the Help Others function to locate an area of the family’s tree to focus your efforts during the visit.
4. **Teach line upon line**—You will have more success if you teach a little here and a little there instead of trying to teach everything at once.

INVITING THE SPIRIT

Many consultants have found that these specific things help or hinder the Spirit during a visit.

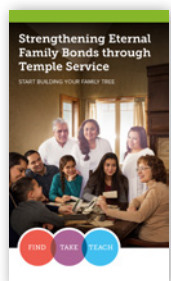

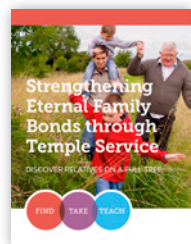
