ESSENTIAL TIPS FOR SUCCESS

 - Proactively help resolve password issues prior to patron visits.
 - Preview patron trees to identify opportunities.

 - Understand and respond to patron needs.
 - Don't overwhelm beginners with requirements.
- 5. Help others to Find, Take, and Teach.**
 - Encourage every staff member to have a personal find, take, and teach experience.
