BEST PRACTICES FOR **SUCCESS**

The Lord has prepared many resources to help you be successful. He’ll guide you to the most appropriate resource to help you meet an individual’s or family’s specific need.

BEFORE YOUR VISIT

1. Discover what the family or individual wants to accomplish.
2. Ask for permission to study their tree.
3. Pray for guidance in choosing the most helpful resources.
4. Use the FamilySearch App gallery as your resource hub.
5. Use resources to prepare an experience in which the family will succeed.

Invite the Spirit to guide your research and to help you find a way to create an experience that will bear witness of the eternal nature of the family.

DURING YOUR VISIT

1. Open your appointment with prayer.
2. After a brief demonstration, let the family or individual do the discovering.
3. Help others recognize when they are feeling the Spirit.
4. Emphasize Find, Take, and Teach.
5. Encourage others to share what they’ve discovered and felt with their friends and family.

Your role is to support and advise. Remember that conversion to family history and temple service comes through doing.
